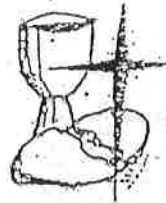

Archdiocese of Toronto – Help Foster a Culture of Life

In June 2016, the federal government of Canada passed legislation that legalized access to assisted suicide and euthanasia. In March 2021, the government announced changes that removed many of the safeguards in the original legislation, while also opening access to those who did not have a foreseeable natural death.

As more and more Canadians are considering euthanasia, we have created a dedicated page on our website to provide information and resources about assisted suicide. Visit www.archtoronto.org/en/offices-and-ministries/sub-sites/euthanasia/home/ to access numerous resources.

A new campaign, launched by the Christian Medical and Dental Association of Canada (CMDA) and supported by the archdiocese, encourages all levels of government to broaden access to quality care and resources for those in need of palliative care, mental health services, and support for people with disabilities in an effort to reduce or eliminate the need for the most vulnerable in our society to utilize Canada's new medical assistance in dying laws.

The **"No Options, No Choice"** campaign is a response to the federal government's revised legislation that changed the eligibility criteria and procedural safeguards for medical assistance in dying (MAID) that came into effect in March of 2021.
